1 3' White Latex Balloon 42847

45 5" (13cm) Red Latex Balloons 43599
25 5" Onyx Black Latex Balloons 43548
23500 Red Latex Balloons 97228
2 2600 Onyx Black Latex Balloons 43937
3500 and 2600 Scraps
Clik-Clik ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Balloon Bond ${ }^{\circledR}$
Sand Weight

## Instructions:

1. Make a 4-balloon cluster with 11 " Onyx Black latex inflated to $6.5^{\prime \prime}(17 \mathrm{~cm})$. Tie the sand weight to the cluster. Set aside.
2. Make a Raisin Twist in the 3 ' White latex, opposite the neck end (see "Raisin Twist" on pg. 2). This will create the attachment point for the head.
3. Inflate the $3^{\prime}$ White latex to $24^{\prime \prime}(61 \mathrm{~cm})$ and tie. Tie the knot end into the Onyx Black cluster from Step 1.
4. Make a 4-balloon cluster with 5 " Red latex sized to 4 " ( 10 cm ). Tie this cluster onto the Raisin Twist using the attached 2600 scrap.
5. Air inflate the Microfoil Shape. Roll up and tie the neck with a 2600 scrap, then tie the Microfoil into the 4 " Red cluster.
6. Inflate a Red 3500 , leaving $1.5^{\prime \prime}(4 \mathrm{~cm})$ uninflated, and tie the ends together into a loop around the 4 " Red cluster. Repeat with a second 3500. >


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## Raisin Twist

Use Raisin Twists to create attachment points, add details and unique distortion techniques.

1. Tie several knots in a 2600 on top of one another to forma a bulky knot. Trim the balloon on each side of the knot.
2. Insert the knot into the balloon that is to be inflated and place in position. Grasp the knot from the outside of the main balloon. Secure the knot in position by tying with an uninflated 2600 .
3. Fully inflate an Onyx Black 2600 , then pinch off a bubble about 24 " from the tip end and deflate the excess. Tie a knot, but leave the long tail. Repeat with a second 2600, then tie the 2600s together leaving about 7" $(18 \mathrm{~cm})$ of stretch in between. Wrap these "arms" into the 4 " Red cluster and position them below the 3500s as shown.
4. To make a button, inflate a $5^{\prime \prime}$ Onyx Black latex to $2.5^{\prime \prime}(6 \mathrm{~cm})$ and tie. Trim the neck below the knot. Attach to the front of the snowman with Balloon Bond. Repeat to make a second button.
